What happens if I have let my proficiency lapse?

Skipped a year or two? Not a problem!

- Please complete a timed pool swim prior to attending skills maintenance and <u>bring this</u> <u>completed form</u> with you to your skills maintenance session.
- > This is 400m under 9 minutes for Bronze or 200m under 5 minutes for SRC.

Skipped more than three years and are returning to surf lifesaving?

Members that have not been proficient in the Bronze or SRC for a period of 3 years or more should contact Alex CTO, Dana Craven so we can discuss your options.
