All members are entered into Surf Life Saving Australia's (SLSA) national membership database called **Surfguard**. You need to create your own member's area account using your **own individual email address**. This **cannot be shared between family members**.


Go to the Members Area

Apply for a **blue card** and once this is processed submit to the office so it can be entered into Surfguard and linked to your membership
